

And it is further hereby ordered, that, at least thirty days notice of said Special Election in said Marion Township shall be first duly given according to law and that the notice of said Election shall be published for at least thirty days next preceding the time of holding said Election in said Marion Township, in the Lawrence Tribune a weekly newspaper published in said Douglas County Kansas and of general circulation in said Marion Township and in said Douglas County and the Sheriff of said Douglas County and State of Kansas, he and he is hereby ordered and directed to give said notice and make, proclamations of said Special Election and the County Clerk of said Douglas County and State of Kansas is hereby ordered and directed to issue forthwith to the Sheriff of said Douglas County Kansas, a duly certified copy hereof.
