And whereas said Board of Canvassers did, on said 13th day of May AD 1887 duly open and canvass the said returns of said Special Election so had and held on said 10th day of May AD 1887 in said Marion Township in said Douglas County Kansas, and did duly find and declare as the result of the canvass of said returns of said Special Election so had and held on said 10th day of May AD 1887 in said Marion Township in Douglas County Kansas that there were one hundred and fifty seven votes of the qualified electors of said Marion Township in said Douglas County Kansas, duly cast in favor of said proposition and of subscribing for and in behalf and in the name of said Marion Township, for one hundred and fifty shares of one hundred dollars each of the Capital Stock of the Missouri Kansas and South Western Railway Company and in payment thereof to issue and deliver to said Railway Company thirty of the Bonds of said Marion Township of the denomination of one hundred dollars each, and that there were one hundred and forty votes of the qualified electors of said Marion Township cast against said proposition and against subscribing for said shares of the Capital Stock of said Railway Company and against the issuing and delivery of said Bonds of said Township in payment of said stock to said Railway Company.

And said Board of Canvassers, as the result of said canvass of the returns of said Special Election did further duly find, determine and declare that there is and was a majority of seven hundred votes of all the votes cast at said Special Election so duly had and held on said 10th day of May AD 1887 in said Marion Township in favor of said proposition and subscribing for and in behalf and in the name of said Marion Township for one hundred and fifty shares of one hundred dollars each of the Capital Stock of the Missouri Kansas and South Western Railway Company and in payment thereof to issue and deliver to said Railway Company, thirty of the Bonds of said Marion Township in said Douglas County Kansas, of the denomination of one hundred dollars each.
