Order Declaring Election Carried and Directing Subscription to the Capital Stock of the Missouri, Kansas & South-Western Railway Company.

Whereas, there was, on the 10th day of May AD 1887, duly submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the Township of Marion in the County of Douglas in the State of Kansas, at a special election duly called and held for that purpose, a proposition to subscribe for and in behalf of said Marion Township for one hundred and fifty shares of one hundred dollars each of the Capital Stock of the Missouri, Kansas & South-Western Railway Company, and in payment thereof to issue to said Railway Company thirty of the Bonds of the said Marion Township of the denomination of Five hundred dollars each upon certain terms and conditions which were more fully appeared in and by the order of the Board of County Commissioners of said Douglas County duly made and entered of record on the 2nd day of April AD 1887, in Journal F. at pages 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 of the proceedings of said Board.

And whereas, at a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of said Douglas County duly held on the 13th day of May AD 1887, for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the votes cast at said election held as aforesaid on said 10th day of May AD 1887, in said Marion Township,
