On the 10th day of June A.D. 1887, a petition signed by
Albert Hare John O. Sullivan Isaac B. Hunt and 189 others, qualified
Electors of Marion Township was filed and presented to the Board of County
Commissioners at a special session June 13th A.D. 1887, praying for an order,
that all persons owning domestic animals to wit: Cows, Horses, neat Cattle
swine, Cattle, Sheep, Hogs and Stock of every kind and description shall
keep ^{said} stock confined and restrained from running at large at any
time, day or night and at all seasons of the year in said Marion
Township, Douglas County, Kansas.

Now therefore we the Board of
County Commissioners, in accordance with the law and in con-
formity with said petition make this order, that all persons
owning domestic animals to wit: Cows, Horses, neat Cattle, swine,
Cattle, Sheep, Hogs and Stock of every kind and description shall
keep such stock restrained from running at large at any
time, day or night and at all seasons of the year in said
Township of Marion, Douglas County, Kans. (see Chap. 104 Sec. 2 session
Laws 1886 for penalty for violation of this order)

This order to be in force now and after the 15th day of
July A.D. 1887.

We have caused this our order to be entered
upon the record of our proceedings and a certified copy
thereof to be published in the Weekly Tribune for three weeks,
