This being the time for opening bids for the purchase of bonds for the use of the County Sinking fund, the Board and County Treasurer proceeded to open the bids received as advertised. The only bid received was from S. W. E. Griffith who offers to sell \$130,000 of Lawrence City Bonds at \$101 and accrued interest.

It was ordered by the Board, that the County Treasurer accept the bid of S. W. E. Griffith and that he purchase for the use of the County Sinking fund thirteen thousand dollars of the bonds of the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas and pay for the same, face of bonds and one per cent premium and accrued interest.
