Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the Office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Walter Chairman, Mr. Draper and J. E. Coy, and County Clerk Joel White.

Read Law in }
Clinton Sp. }

On the 25th day of June A.D. 1887, a petition signed by R. A. Stua, E. Bartington, Ch. Wicks and 142 other qualified electors of Clinton Sp. was filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, July 9, 1887, praying for an order that all domestic animals of every kind shall be kept confined and prevented from running at large within the aforesaid township at any time between the first day of January and the 31st day of December.

Now therefore, we the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with the law and in conformity with the said petition make this order. That all persons owning domestic animals of any kind, shall keep the same confined and prevented from running at large within the aforesaid township, at any time, between the first day of January and the 31st day of December (See Chap. 109, Sec. 2, Laws Kansas 1886 for penalty for violation of this order.)

This order to take effect and be of force on and after the 25th day of August A.D. 1887.

We have caused this our order to be entered upon the records of our proceedings and a certified copy thereof to be published in the Lawrence Weekly Journal, of Lawrence, Kansas for three weeks.
