It being uncertain where the true course of the County line Road is, between Douglas and Johnson Counties on the East line of Douglas County, by reason of the removal of the monuments and marks by which said road was originally described. Your petitioners respectfully ask that you direct the County Surveyor to survey the same and make a return thereof as required by law.
