At the April session of the Board two petitions for roads were presented to the Board - one signed by John Dillies and others - and the other signed by Eli J. Peterson and others. Viewers were appointed in each case. Notices were published in the Weekly Tribune in each case. But on account of the principal petitioners' failure to post notice and notify second viewers - no legal view was had.

It is now ordered by the Board that the Road Notices be again published - and the said viewers in conjunction with the County Surveyor meet at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notices and proceed to view and lay out said roads, according to law and instructions as recorded on pages 16 and page 20 of this Record book.
