

Lawrence House, Wednesday Oct. 12, 1887.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There was present Commissioners Mr. Draper and J. C. Gay, and County Clerk J. S. White, absent Commissioner Newton.

In the Matter of a Road
Petitioned for by Benj. Stowes

On the 17th day of September 1887, a Road Petition signed by Benjamin Stowes and 16 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road described as follows, to wit:

Locate and re-locate - Beginning 10 rods East of the North East Corner of the S. E. 1/4 Sec 34, T. 17, R. 18.

Thence west along North line of said S. E. 1/4 (or as near as practicable) to intersect road in Center of Section 34, T. 17, R. 18.

Vacate: Old road between the points above mentioned, not covered by this location and relocation.

Said petition was accompanied with bond, as required by law signed by Benj. Stowes as principal and M. C. Porter surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view.

Whereupon, said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered, that J. A. Kelly, H. C. Cummings & R. S. Patton be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this County Board.

Appropriation. The Board appropriated a sum sufficient to pay the bills and claims as allowed at this regular October session; which bills and claims, are duly recorded on Pages 95, 96, 97, 98, 99 & 100. Commissioners Record of Lawrence Co. 2.

Treasurer's Examination

The Board appointed Carson Hicks and Adam Olson to assist the Probate Judge in Examination of County Treasury.

Adjournment. On Motion The Board adjourned, sine die.
