Order to County Treasurer

It was ordered that any lands or lands lots that may have been sold for any term less than one year, and bought in by the County and remain unredeemed for two years from date of such sale, the County Treasurer is hereby authorized to furnish the owners of such Lands & Lots to redeem the same for amount of original sale and two per cent interest.

Ritzman Ditch.

The Board having under consideration the bids for work on the Ritzman Ditch - which was opened on 20th inst. and receiving the lowest bid was too high, decided that, in justice to the parties interested, at whose expense the work would be done; that all bids be rejected, and that the work to be done on said ditch - be again advertised, bids to be opened Saturday Nov. 26th 1887. Work to be completed March 1st 1888.
