The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. met in regular session pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Walton Chairman, W. Draper and J. Ellsby, and County Clerk Joel S. White.

Proposition of
Russell Bowman & Co.

The Board having ^{under consideration} the aforesaid proposition it was ordered that the County Treasurer execute and the County Clerk assign to Russell Bowman & Co. Lot 16 Block 4 South Lawrence Sale of 1869 for amount of original sale, 10% int. per annum and cost of transfer.

A. M. Hill's bond as County Surveyor was presented approved and filed.

Appropriations to
build bridges }

Appropriation was made for a pro rata share of the cost of the bridge across Mud Creek between Douglas and Jefferson Counties - provided, the entire cost to Douglas County shall not exceed \$300.⁰⁰

Also appropriated \$175.⁰⁰ to build a bridge across a branch of Captains Creek on Dec. 15, 1887.
