

Lawrence Kans Jan'y 10th 1888

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. met in regular session pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioner John Walton Chairman Wm. D. Raper and O. Butler and County Clerk Wm. D. Grunice

Appointment.

The Board appointed W. H. Gill of Tullahoma and L. P. Baldwin Lawrence Kans. to assist the Probate Judge in the examination of the County Treasurers

In the matter of a Road }
Petitioned for by Jacob Geiger }

On the 10th day of January 1888 a road petition signed by Jacob Geiger and 19 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road, described as follows, to wit:

Locate. Beginning at the center of section 16, Town 14, Range 19. Running thence west on the most practicable route about one and one quarter miles. Thence north on the most practicable route about one half mile. Thence west on the most practicable route about one quarter of a mile. Thence north on the most practicable route one half mile to connect (intersect) with Road No 361, as shown on road map of said County.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Jacob Geiger as principal and S. H. Carnahan as surety, in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that S. M. Reynolds, J. A. Darnold and Wm. Carder be appointed Viewers of the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in Willow Springs Township on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this County Board.
