Appropriations:

That the Board of County Commissioners appropriate & the same is hereby appropriated, the sum of (\$350.00) three hundred fifty & 00/100 Dollars for the building of a Female Ward at the County Jail as per plan and specification & contract on file in the office of the County Clerk. Also (\$150.00) one hundred fifty & 00/100 Dollars for repairs on County Jail, said repairs to be made under the direction of the Sheriff & approved by the Board, all the members voting "Aye".

Auditing The Board completed the auditing of claims & acts for this Jan'y session.

Appropriation

Road

In the matter of a Road
Petitioned for by Geo. W. Petchick }

On the 11th day of January 1888 a Road Petition signed by Geo. W. Petchick & 14 others was filed & this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas praying for the location of a certain road described as follows, to wit:

Locate. Beginning at a stake in the North boundary & 11 ²⁵/₁₀₀ Chains west of the North East Corner of the South West quarter of Sec. 7, Tp. 13, Range 19. Thence West on quarter Sec. line as near as practicable to intersect a road running North & South distance about one half mile & locate same.

Locate as follows. Beginning at a stake in the North boundary & 11 ²⁵/₁₀₀ Chains west of the North East Corner of S.W. quarter of Section 7, Tp. 13, R. 19.
