Halderman be appointed as viewers of the proposed road & that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in Clinton Township on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view & lay out said road according to law giving all parties a hearing & make due report of their proceedings to this County Board.
