

Lawrence Kansas Feb 18th A.D. 1888

The Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session at the office of the County Clerk

There were present John Walton Chairman
Jas. Graper. Oliver Butler and County Clerk M.D. Granda
Appointment. Trustee.

Appointment of Trustee for Palmyra Township.

The Board having the aforesaid matter under consideration, and the several petitions having been examined by them an informal ballot was taken which resulted as follows:

W.W. Asher received two votes and M. Sturdivan, one. a formal ballot was then taken in which Mr W.W. Asher received all the votes cast. Thereupon he was declared duly appointed as Trustee of Palmyra Township to fill vacancy occasioned by the death of Sam C.D. Deeks.

County Clerk instructed to issue certificate of appointment to Mr Asher.

In the matter of
Petition of Chas Cunningham a pauper of Clinton Township, asking for aid to build a house.

It was ordered that the County Clerk issue an order to C.D. Bruce & Son for Lumber and material to the amount of Eighty dollars, said order subject to the conditions of an agreement and Bond of said Chas Cunningham on file in this office. (ord. issued Feb 19th)

Hard Law Petition
Eudora Township }

On the 17th day of December A.D. 1887 a petition signed by G. Duley, Sam Stanley, Albert Griffin and 238 others, qualified electors of Eudora Township, was filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas at a Special Session held Feb 18th A.D. 1888, praying for an order that all persons owning horses, mules, cattle, sheep and swine shall keep them confined and restrained from running at large at any time of the day or night and at all seasons of the year in said Township of Eudora.

Now therefore we the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with the law and in conformity with the said petition make this Order
