The Board of County Commissioners met at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present John Walton Chairman
Oliver Butler, W^m Draper and County Clerk M.D. Greenlee
The Board continued auditing claims vs. County.

Road Petition of }
Fred Glead } was called up and taken under consideration
by the Board, who gave parties interested
a hearing.

The Board having the aforesaid Petition under consideration
It was "Ordered" that the prayer of the petitioners be
granted and the road be established as reported by the viewers.

Damage awarded to W.H. Duncan \$45.00 and to
John Brown \$40.00 (see page 50. this record)
Viewers Report.

We met at the place of beginning of said road in
Wakarusa Township Aug 29th 1887. and proceeded to view the route of the road
petitioned for, which was surveyed under our direction by A.M. Hill, Deputy
Co. Surveyor. the field notes and plat of which survey are hereto attached ^{and form one of this report}
(See Road Record No. 4. Page 25 Road No. 445)

and after careful deliberation we are of the opinion that said route is
practicable and of public utility, and recommend that it be granted as
located and surveyed, and that it be established and opened forty
(40) feet wide
