The Board appointed I. St. Van Hosen and
Capt Oliver Barber to assist the Probate Judge in
his quarterly examination of the funds in the County Treas.

In the matter of a
Road petitioned for by W. A. Marshall

On the 17th day of April A.D. 1888
signed by W. A. Marshall and 12 others, ^{who were legally sworn in said County} was filed and presented
to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas
praying for the location of a certain road described as follows
to wit: Beginning as near as practical 80 rods North of
the south east cor. of the west 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec 17. T. 14 N. R. 19.
Thence west as near as practical to the Sec. line between Sections 17 and
15. Thence N. on Sec. line to the S. W. Cor. of Sec. 8.

said Petition was accompanied with a bond, ^{as required by law} signed by
P. W. Johanning and W. A. Marshall. in the amount of all costs
and expenses accruing on the view.

Whereupon said Bond was approved
by the Board. and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board
that the law had been substantially complied with.

It was ordered that Adam Lind, John Meersbinder and F. M.
Price be appointed as viewers of the proposed road. and that
they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the
