 Douglas County, a certain judgment standing in favor
 of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kans.
 on a Tax Warrant.

Whereas the said Otto Menger has
 by his petition made it to appear that the taxes
 assessed against his name in the year 1883. ^{and} for which
 said tax warrant was issued, was an unwarranted ^{and}
 illegal assessment, as to him the said Otto Menger.

Whereas this Board is satisfied of the truth of the facts
 as stated in said petition; therefore, It is hereby Ordered
 that said judgment against Otto Menger now standing on
 the judgment roll of the District Court of said County
 which judgment is based upon a tax warrant for personal
 property filed by the Treasurer of said County, be ^{and} the
 same is hereby declared to be erroneous ^{and} void, and the
 County Attorney of said County is hereby authorized ^{and} empowered
 to release ^{and} discharge said judgment on said judgment roll
^{and} execution docket of said Court, referring to this order.
^{and} any ^{and} all property of said Otto Menger within the
 County of Douglas ^{and} State of Kansas is hereby released
 from any ^{and} all lien or encumbrance by reason of said
 judgment.
