Road Petition! In the matter of
a Road petitioned for by Eben Baldwin

on the 6th day of July
1888, a road petition signed by Eben Baldwin and 15 others was filed
and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County K.S.
Praying for the Location and Vacate of a certain road in Douglas
County described as follows.

Locate. Beginning at N.W. cor of S.W. 1/4 of Secto 15. T. 12. R. 19.
Thence south on sec. line between Sec No 15 and 16, to low water
mark of Lake. Thence in a S. Easterly direction on the
most practicable route to intersect Road No. 64.

Vacate. Old road No. 64 between point of beginning and
ending.

said petition was accompanied with Bond
as required by law, signed by Eben Baldwin and Lynn F. Watkins as
Security in the sum of all expenses and costs according to view. Survey
and laying out of said road.

That the said bond was approved by the Board
and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board, that the law had been
substantially complied with. It was ordered that Gordon Neal.

W.J. Kennedy and Wm Brown be appointed viewers of the proposed road
that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place
of beginning in Wakarusa Township on the day designated in their
Notice and proceed to view and locate and vacate said road according
to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report
of their proceedings to this Board.

communication under consideration. It was ordered that the County
