Specifications for abutments for a bridge
across Rock Creek in Marion Township.
Length of abutments 18 ft at the base and 11 ft in thickness
to slope to 16 ft in length and 2 ft. in thickness at the top.
Height of abutments 16 ft.

also to construct four wing walls each to be 8 ft long and
built in and connected at the corners of abutment walls.
said wings to be 2½ ft. thick at the bottom and to slope to
1½ ft. in thickness at the top and to be 16 ft in height.

The first 4 ft of base of abutment walls to be built
of white limestone rock and all face rock to be not less
than 6 in in thickness in said four ft of wall.

all of said walls to be built on solid earth or rock foundation.

The Board having the aforesaid specifications under
consideration and also bids for the construction of the same
Contract. was awarded to D.P. Weybright, for the sum of (\$95.00) ninety
five dollars, he being the lowest bidder.
