Road Petitioned for by
Geo. W. Petefish

On the 11th day of Jan'y 1888. a road petition signed
by Geo. W. Petefish and 14 others was filed and presented
to the Board of County Commissioners on April 11th
A.D. 1888. "See page 100. this record." (same was passed to July session and not being
called up at that time went over to this Oct session.) praying for the location
and vacation of a road in said County. as follows.

Locate. Beginning at a stake in the N boundary and 11th Ch. W. of N.E. Corner of
S 7th E of Sec. 7. S 13. R 19. Thence N on E Sec. line as near as
practicable to intersect road running North and South distance about
one half mile. And

Vacates as follows.

Begin at a stake in the North boundary S 11th Ch. W. of N.E. Corner of
S 7th E of Sec. 7. S 13. R 19. Thence S 72nd E 50th Ch. Thence S 28th W 2 Ch.
Thence S 63rd W 2nd Ch. Thence S 89th W 23rd Ch.

said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law. signed by
Geo. W. Petefish as principal and C. Wicks as surety in the sum of all
expenses and costs accruing on the view

whereupon said bond was approved by the board. and it appearing to
the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially
complied with. it was Ordered. that W.B. Porter, J.B. Portner and A.
Haldeman be appointed viewers of the proposed roads and that they
meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning
in Clinton Township on the day designated in their notice. and
proceed to view and lay out said road according to law. giving to
all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings
to the County Board.

The aforesaid petition being under consideration. no legal objections
having been offered against the establishment and vacation of said
roads and believing the same to be of public utility.
