on the 30th day of June A.D. 1888 a road petition signed by J.L. Horner & 15 others was filed & presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County praying for the Location & Vacation of a certain road described as follows, Locate!

Beginning at the NE Cor of N¹/₂ of N¹/₂ of Sec. 13, T. 14, R. 18. Thence N to NE Cor of S¹/₂ of Sec. 12, T. 14, R. 18. said road No. 175. being in an angular direction through land described. And Vacate.

Road No. 175. from the SE Cor of N¹/₂ of N¹/₂ of Sec. 13, T. 14, R. 18. Marion Surf said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by J.L. Horner as Principal & Wm. Meachiner as surety
