On the 1st day of June 1888 a road petition signed by Mark Miglaro & 27 others was filed & this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County. Praying for the Location & Vacation of certain roads described as follows. to wit: Locate!

Beginning at a point 40 ft west of the center of Sec 3. 512. R18. T2E & on the north side of a hedge fence now standing to the center of Whitfield St. in the Town of Leecompton. & Vacate!

The County road formerly laid upon 6th Street between Whitfield Street & West line of N & E of Sec 3 512. R18. in said town of Leecompton.

said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Mark Miglaro as principal & D. D. Timmons & H. Hafer as securities in the sum of all expenses & costs accruing on view.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board. & it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was Ordered! that J. C. Vincent, A. Pindley & P. D. Pontius be appointed viewers of the proposed road, & that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in Leecompton Township. on the day designated in their notice & proceed to view & lay out said road giving to all parties a hearing & make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
