The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County
met in special session at the office of the County Clerk

There were present John Walton Chairman,
Oliver Butler. Mr Draper ^{and} County Clerk M.D. Greenlaw

Bank Petitions.

Petitions of the Watkins National Bank ^{and} also
of the Douglas County National Bank of Lawrence,
Praying to be assigned as a depository of a part of the
County funds as required by law. ^{and} agree to file bond
^{and} pay the same rate rate of interest as now being paid
by the other banks,

The board set the hour of 2 o'clock p.m.
for hearing said petitions,

The hour of two p.m. having arrived the board
gave parties interested a hearing,
motion by Mr Draper that the Watkins National Bank ^{and}
the Douglas County National Bank of Lawrence Kans be ^{and}
the same are hereby designated as depositories of a part of
the County's funds as provided by law motion carried
all members voting ^{aye}.

Motion by Mr Butler that the said
banks pay (2) two per cent per annum on the average daily
balances, under the same conditions as the other banks now
pay. ^{and} that the County Clerk notify the County Seal
of said order. Carried.

Bonds approved!

The bonds of the Watkins National Bank ^{and} of
the Douglas County National Bank, for the sum
of fifty thousand dollars each were received. Examined
^{and} approved. ^{and} ordered placed on file.

Tax Petition of
J S Brown {

Praying the Board to rule of 1885 ^{and} endorsement
of 1886. on Lot No 51 N.J. St City of Lawrence. Cancelled as
an illegal sale.
