The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met
at the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment

Tax Petition of
Wm P. Sinclair }

Praying for an order authorizing the County
Treasurer of Douglas County to assign at the face thereof without
costs of transfer, such tax certificates as he may select
prior to the sale of 1884, held by the County, in the N.E. 1/4
of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. No. 29, Township 12, Range 20, being what
is known as Addition No 12, North Lawrence.

In consideration of the granting of the above Petition, the said
Wm P. Sinclair hereby agrees that he will release the County
of Douglas from any liability to him by reason of prior
sales to the County, or any subsequent Certificates or deeds
which he may have on land covered by the Certificates he
may select under the above proposition.

The Board having the aforesaid petition under consid-
eration, on motion granted.

Tax Petition of the
U.P.R.R. Co. by
Wm P. Sinclair }

as follows. I have the honor to represent that
the Union Pacific Railway Company is the owner in fee simple
by deed from the City of Lawrence, of the N.E. 1/4 of Blocks No. 3,
4, 5, and 6, in that part of the City of Lawrence known as
North Lawrence, Kans. And that against said property there are
certain old tax sales for a number of years to Douglas County.
That said Union Pacific Railway Company is desirous of
perfecting its title, so far as may be, to said blocks,
and hereby offers to pay to the County of Douglas, for
an Assignment of all tax sale Certificates held by Douglas
County against said lands the sum of One Hundred Dollars,
without costs of transfer.

The Board having the aforesaid
Petition and proposition under consideration. It was ordered
that the U.P.R.R. Co. may redeem all sales to the County
of any land in said blocks for the sum of Twenty five
Dollars, without cost of redemption, providing said Company
shall first exhibit to the Treasurer of Douglas County satisfactory
evidence that all existing individual sales or Tax Title Deeds
