The aforesaid petition of Mark Migliario as recorded in Comm² Record B, page 141, being under consideration the following action was had thereon by the Board of County Commissioners, to wit,

upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against that part of said road hereinafter mentioned, ^{and} believing the same to be of public utility it is "Ordered" that the viewers report of view ^{and} report ^{and} plat of survey be adopted, as follows.

Beginning at a point 40 ft west ^{and} fifteen feet north of the center of Sec 3. T12. R18.E. Thence Ta-9° E. East on north side of Hedge, which is on the Half Sec line in Sec 3. 950 feet to the center of Whitfield St. in the town of Leecompton.

Also Vacate

Beginning at a point 83 feet North of the intersection of the center lines of 6th & Whitfield Street in Leecompton. Thence west parallel with Sixth Street 191½ ft. Thence South parallel with Whitfield Street 83 feet to center of Sixth Street. West on center of Sixth Street 758½ feet ^{and} intersect West line of N.E.¼ of Sec 3. T12. R18.

^{and} that said road be declared located ^{and} established as a public highway in accordance therewith.

Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record ^{and} Plat as Road No. ^{and} the Trustees of Leecompton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel, 30 feet wide.
