as Treasurer Examiners.

Road Petitioned for by

The Board having the aforesaid petition under  
consideration and being advised by the City Genl. Theodor  
S.D. Bradford that they had proper and legal jurisdiction  
appointed Wm. Roe, Chas. Lottholz and O.P. Kennedy as  
viewers, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor  
at the place of beginning in Grant Township on the day  
designated in their notice and proceed according to law  
giving to all parties a hearing and make due report  
of their proceedings to the County Board.

Jail The Board visited and inspected the County Jail and found every  
thing in a very satisfactory condition, so far as the cleanliness  
and the means at hand would permit.

Rent of Court Room

The Board upon request rented the Court room  
to the Paladian Literary Society for the sum of one dollar  
per month. (to pay for gas) same to be paid to the Sheriff.

Auditing

The Board proceeded with the auditing of accounts
