at the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment.

Bridge! The Board fixed Wed^y Jan^y 23rd 1889, at eleven o'clock
a.m. as a time to meet the County Commissioners of Johnson
County, at the bridge on the County line to inspect the same.

Road In the matter of a Road
Petitioned for by Eben Baldwin

On the 16th day of January 1889 a road
petition signed by Eben Baldwin ^{and} 23 others was filed ^{and}
this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of
Douglas County Kansas, praying for the Relocation, Change
or Altering of a certain road in said County, as follows:

Beginning at the corners of Sections No. 9, 10, 15 ^{and} 16,
Township 12, Range 19. Thence in a South East direction
along established road to South Bank of Lake.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond
as required by law, signed by Eben Baldwin as principal.
R.D. Mason ^{and} J.M. Stuelin as sureties in the amount
of all costs ^{and} expenses accruing on the view, survey ^{and} laying
out of said road.

Whereupon said bond was approved by
the Board, ^{and} it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board
that the law had been substantially complied with, it was
"Ordered" that O.L. Cox L.J. Sperry ^{and} Ed Zimmerman
be appointed viewers of the proposed road, ^{and} that
they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the
place of beginning in Wakarusa Township on the day
designated in their notice, ^{and} proceed to view ^{and} locate
said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing
^{and} make due report of their proceedings to the Board of
County Commissioners.

Appropriation! The Board appropriated the sum of \$20⁰⁰ or so
much thereof as required to pay bill of F. East & Co
for bank checks. Co Clerk ^{and} Chairman of Board to issue
warrant on presentation of bill.
