as recorded in C.R.R. pages 140 & 141. being under consideration
the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commrs
to wit!

upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered
against that part of said road hereinafter mentioned ^{and} believing
the same to be of public utility it is "Ordered" that the Viewers
report of view, ^{and} report ^{and} plat of survey be adopted,
as follows. Beginning see Road Record page also Road No.

^{and} that said road be declared located ^{and} established
as a public high way in accordance therewith.
full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record
^{and} plat as Road No. 45, ^{and} the Trustee of Marion Township
be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public
travel (40) forty feet wide.

Road petitioned for by
J. Hoskinson ^{and} 21 others

The aforesaid petition of J.
Hoskinson ^{and} others being under consideration the following action
thereon was had by the Board of County Commrs.

to wit. upon due consideration no legal objections having
been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter
mentioned, ^{and} believing the same to be of public
utility. It is "Ordered" that the dedication of said
road be adopted as follows!

Beginning at the N.W. Cor. of Sec. 14 Town 14 Range 20.
thence South one mile to the S.W. Cor. of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 14. Town
14. Range 20. ^{and} that the said road be laid out between
growing hedge rows ^{and} not more than (20) thirty feet wide
^{and} that said road be declared located ^{and} established as a
public high way in accordance therewith. full record
