

Road ! In the matter of a
Road petitioned for by
W. A. Cardwell & others

The aforesaid petition of W. A. Cardwell as recorded in C. R. F. pages 157 & 158. being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners "to wit,

upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is "Ordered" that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows. Beginning at the intersection of Born and Fourth Streets in the vacated portion of Lecompton, thence $\text{Var } 10^{\circ} 2'$ East.

East at 7. Ch. cross draw - bears N. E.

at 10^{20} Ch. begin to ascend hill. at 18^{65} Ch. corner stone

" 27. Ch. set stone. $54^{\circ} 3' 8''$ Ch. set stone.

at $83^{\circ} 8'$ Ch. set stone at a point 1^{24} Ch. S of the intersection of Fourth and Jones Streets "Vacated"

Thence $\text{Var } 10^{\circ} 2'$ East. South on center of Jones Street "Vacated" $218'$ Ch. to the middle of Sixth Street.

and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. And the Trustee of Lecompton Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel (30) thirty feet wide.

Appropriation!

The Board appropriated a sum sufficient to pay the claims allowed by them at this the April session 1889. as Recorded in County Commissioners Claim Record of allowances on pages No 155 to 164 Inclusive.
