

Lawrence Kansas June 3rd A.D. 1889

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met at the Office of the County Clerk as a Board of Equalization

There were present Wm. D. Baker Chairman, John Walton, Oliver Butler and County Clerk M.D. Greenlee

The Board considered individual assessments and on motion adjourned as a Board of Equalization and organized as Board of County Council in Special session.

Bridge

The contract or agreement for the rebuilding of the South abutment at Reynolds bridge across Wainwright Creek was let to C. Christenson.

It follows: Abutment to be 30 feet high. 24 feet in length at base and 18 feet at top. and to be 8 feet in thickness at base and 3 feet at top for which he is to receive 13 cents per cubic foot for stone work and excavation included.

Dimensions however subject to change by the Board of County Commissioners.

The County to furnish lumber for foundation of said abutment if required? and Christenson to put it in front of charge.

Darnold. The Board employed J. F. Darnold at \$2.00 per day for the time actually employed in putting said bridge upon the abutments when same are completed.

Windmill for Farm!

The Board accepted the proposition of the Lawrence Climbing and Heating Co. to erect a 10 foot eclipse wind mill at the County Farm at \$85.00 Pump at \$15.00 cylinder \$4.00 Gal. Iron Pipe 1 1/4 in @ 10¢ per ft. 1 in @ 9¢ per foot.
