

Lawrence Kansas July 5th A.D. 1889.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas met at the office of the County Clerk, Bureau at adjournment.

All the members being present and the County Clerk.

One motion of Mr Butler the Resolution to pay a bounty on Wolf, Coyote and Wild Cat scalps passed by the Board April 21st 1885 C.R. & Page 418. be, and the same is hereby revoked, all members voting aye.

Bounty on Scalps

The Board having under consideration a motion to repeal Ch. 73. Laws of 1885. being an Act authorizing a bounty upon Wolf, Coyote, Wild Cat, Fox and Rabbit scalps. Laws of 1889 Ch. 90.

It was "Ordered"

That on and after this date a Bounty of (\$3⁰⁰) three dollars each for "Full Grown" Wolf, Coyote and Wild Cat scalps will be paid for all such as are caught and killed in Douglas County and (\$1⁰⁰) one dollar each for the above named scalps which are "not" full grown.

Resolution:

The following resolution was passed by the Board. Whereas the Records of the County show that the Chairman of the County Board has been paid for extra duties performed from the organization of the County up to and including the year of 1884. and

Whereas John Walton served as chairman of said Board for the years 1885, 1887 & 1888. and Wm Draper for the year 1886. without recompense for said extra duties and

Whereas the Board believing that equity and justice demand that said parties should be partly recompensed for said duties therefore

Resolved that \$40⁰⁰ is hereby appropriated and tendered to John Walton as Chairman of the County Board for the year of 1888.
