Praying for a change and Relocation of a certain road as follows. Beginning in the center of road No 400. In the center of Sec. No 10. S 15 & 19. Rence west on the 2^d Sec. line to intersect said road No 400. In Willow Springs Township.

Dedication.

On Dec 28th 1889. The following dedications were filed with the County Clerk. To wit.

To the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County State of Kansas.

We the undersigned do hereby dedicate to the County of Douglas for a Public Highway. The following described lands. Namely 20 feet on the north side of the 1/2 Section line Beginning in the center of Sec No 10. S 15 & 19. Rence west to intersect Road No 400. in Willow Springs Township Douglas Co. Kans. And in addition to the 20 feet above described sufficient land to make good approaches to and from the bridge lately erected over Ottawa Creek on said 1/2 Sec line near where said line crosses creek. In witness whereof We have hereunto set our hands this 27th day of December A.D. 1889.
