

to be made as principal. M. L. Kennedy and W. H. Humphrey as sureties in the amount of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, survey, and laying out of said road, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted or the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and in appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, It was ordered that H. H. Pinley, C. W. Porter and E. L. Saylor be appointed as viewers of said proposed roads. And that they mark in conjunction with the County surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notices and proceed to view and lay out said road in accordance to law, giving all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

The Board audited claims against the County and
