Road. In the matter of a
Road petitioned for by
Benj Ulrich

On the 7th day of Jan'y. 1890 a road petitioned for by Benj Ulrich and 26 others was filed with the County Clerk and this day presented to the Board of Co Commrs of Douglas County, Kans. Praying for the location of a certain road as follows.

Beginning at the center of Sec.

11. T. 14. R. 19. E. in Willow Springs Township.

Thence east on the half section line about E. five eighths of a mile to intersect a road running north and south in the West 1/2 of Sec. 12. T. 14. R. 19.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond signed by Benjamin Ulrich as Principal and Barbara Bailey as surety. ^{In the amount of all costs and expenses accruing on survey and survey of said road} Thereupon said bond was approved by the Board and in appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was Ordered that Moses McMillen, J. F. Brown and W. T. Williams be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County surveyor at the place of beginning in Willow Springs Township on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

The Board audited claims against the County and on motion adj- to Jan'y. 11th 1890
