

Lawrence Kansas Jan. 13th A.D. 1890

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas met in regular session at the office of the County Clerk pursuant to adjournment.

There were present Mr. Draper Chairman John Walton. Oliver Butler and County Clerk M.D. Franklin

Chairmanships.

The hour of 12 o'clock noon having arrived Mr. J.C. Moore County Commissioner elect for 3rd Comm. Dist. being present took the oath of office. After wards the Board proceeded to reorganize.

Vote by ballot. Oliver Butler having received two votes was declared duly elected Chairman for the ensuing year.

Treasurer Examiners

The Board appointed Chas. F. Hill of Eudora and Geo. Petefish of Lawrence O.D. to assist the Hon. Probate Judge as Trial Examiners as required by law.

Road petitioned for by
Isaac Flora

On the 3rd day of Jan. 1890 a road petitioned for by Isaac Flora and 18 others was filed with the County Clerk and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. Praying for the location and vacation of a road in said County as follows.

Location! Beginning at the Corner of Sections 17, 18, 19 & 20. of Township 15. Range 19. Thence running North between sections 17 and 18. and numbered on the Road record No 76.

Vacation!

We ask that said road between the North West Quarter of Section 17. and the North East quarter of Section 18. be vacated and straightened out. And a new road located.

The said Petition was accompanied with a bond signed by Isaac Flora as principal and Geo. W. Hayslett as surety in the amount of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, survey and laying out of said road. In case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established.
