

Lawrence Kansas April 10th AD 1890.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Oliver Butler Chairman

John Walton, J. C. Moore and County Clerk M. D. Grunler.

Road. In the matter of a road
petition of Benj. Ulrich

The aforesaid petition of Benjamin Ulrich as recorded in C.R. & 217, being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners to wit. Upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility it is "Ordered" that the viewers report of view and report and plan of survey be adopted as follows.

Beginning at the center cor. of Sec. 11. T14. R19E. Thence East (Ta 8° 30') 2180 feet when I placed a stone 3+12+18. Then I angle 47° 45' L. and run 300 feet when I placed a stone 12+12+24. Then I angle 67° R. and run 200 feet when I placed a stone 3+12+20. Then I angle 35° 18' R. and run 190 feet to center corner on east line of Sec. 11. T14. R19E. Then I angle 55° 10' L. and run 420 feet and intersect at right angles a road running North & South in Sec. 12 T14. R19E where I placed a stone 3+8+12.

The first 1000 feet of the road to be (40) forty feet wide, 20 feet each side of center line of Sec. 11. T14. R19E. From this point (24) thirty four feet wide 1180 feet. 20 feet on North side of said center line of Sec. 11. and 14 feet on south side of said center line of Sec. 11. because of a hedge on south side, from this point (20) forty feet to intersection of said road through Sec. 12. T14. R19E. and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and placed as Road No 458 and the Trustee of Willow Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

O. Butler Chairman, J. C. Moore, and Co. Clerk inspected the County road in Frank Twp. along S 78° 45' Sec 18. T22. R20 where Kansas river is encroaching on said road, and report that it will be necessary to increase the width, or relocate said road.
