 Bridge Petition.

A petition praying for a County bridge across the Wakarusa river on the section line between Secs 13 & 14. N. 3. R. 18. Clinton Township. estimated cost of bridge \$4,000.00 said petition was filed July 7<sup>th</sup> 1885. and was called up by Capt. Oliver Barber, Mr. McKill, Hook, Ray and others who urged the Board to grant the prayer of said petitioners. The Board took same under advisement "without action".

Bridge

A petition praying for a bridge across Mud creek in Frank Township was presented to the Board who gave the parties interested a hearing and took same under advisement "without action".

Prisoner Release!

A petition of Harry Curtis praying to be released from the County jail was presented to the Board. said petition was signed by the Court before whom conviction was had. and 103. other resident tax payers of Douglas County.

upon due consideration the Board "granted" the prayer of said petitioners "except as to fine and costs". the County Clerk was instructed to issue an order for release upon bailment to the Sheriff of \$1.00 to apply on costs (order issued)
