Road

In the matter of a
Road petitioned for by
E. Zimmerman & 19 others }

On the 15th day of April 1890, a road petition signed by E. Zimmerman & 19 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas praying for the vacation and relocation of a road in said County to wit: Vacate as follows.

Begin at NW cor. of land owned by J. Morrison in Sec. 18. T12. R20. running South and East to his South East corner. and

Locate as follows. Begin at SW corner of NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 18. T12. R20. Thence running east about 66 Rods. Thence South 80 Rods.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond signed by E. Zimmerman as principal. D. Lewis and J. C. Barby as sureties in the amount of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, survey and laying out of said road, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, It was ordered that J. L. Gilmore A. C. Gurne and John Wilson be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in Grant Township County Surveyor at the place of beginning in Grant Township on the day designated in their notices and proceed to view and
