

Lawrence Kansas June 3rd & 4th A.D. 1890

The County Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment
Pursuant

O. Butler Chairman. John Walton
J. B. Moore and County Clerk M. D. Greenlee

The Board
considered Individual assessments and adjourned without
action to

June 4th 1890.

When they convened pursuant
to adjournment. Still being pursuant.

The Board "Ordered"
a reduction of \$100⁰⁰ on one Horse assessed to Wm. Surgeon
in Kanwaka Township. (on account of defective eye)

After consulting with all of the persons
interested. The Board "Ordered" that the assessments of
said Companies property be changed in Wakarusa
Grant and Kanwaka Townships, from amounts as
now assessed, to a basis of \$40⁰⁰ per mile for Instru-
ments. Poles and one wire, and \$5⁰⁰ per mile for each
additional wire.

On motion Adjourned to June 5th A.D. 1890
