

Lawrence Kansas July 9th A.D. 1890.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas met in Regular Session pursuant to adjournment

All of the members and the County Clerk

being present.

City and County Officers!

The Hon. Mayor and Committee of the Council of the City of Lawrence Kansas, presented a plan and specifications for the following changes and additions to the County Officers, to wit:

Enlarge vault in the office of the Register of Deeds, also enlarge office used by him by including room now used by the County Supt of Public Instructions.

An additional office and vault for the County Supt. located on first story and on north side of City building. Also office room and vault for use of County Attorney adjoining one for County Supt.

Other vault for use of the office of the Clerk of the District Court.

Also additional vault room for use of the County Treasurer office.

Reference to be had to plans and specifications made by Alex Shaw and submitted to the Board for approval.

Whereupon the Board accepted the aforesaid plans and specifications and

Agreed that when the aforesaid rooms and vaults were ready for occupancy to enter into a contract with the City of Lawrence for a period of five years for the use of said county officers, and the same now used by the County at an annual rental of \$1,700⁰⁰ per annum payable quarterly.

An motion adjourned to July 10th 1890
