The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas
met in Special session in the office of the County Clerk
There were present

Tax Petition of Chas Anderson,

Praying to be allowed to redeem from
the County Lot No. 136. R.D. 5 & City of Lawrence, sale of 1861.
tax of 1860. City No 1125. Amk \$12⁰⁰ for the original amount and
costs of redemption without interest

On motion granted.

Kansas River Bridge Piers!

Holland Wheeler "Civil Engineer"
filed plan for repair of piers of Kansas river bridge at
Lawrence Kans. with the Board of County Commrs.
as follows.

Posts 6 ft long to be secured vertically across the corner
of stone which have crumbled away - by drilling holes through the
piers between the corners.

Laying of 2" Oak plank to be spiked to
the posts so as to entirely cover the injured portions of the abutments.
The space between the plank and the face of the pier to be filled
with Portland cement concrete made of 1 part cement - 2 1/2 parts
sand. & parts broken stone, not more than 2" diameter - well ram-
med in place.

Whereupon the Board accepted said Plan and employed
Mr Wheeler to purchase material and superintend the repair of
said pier.

City Water Company!

The Board authorized the County Clerk to contract
with the City Water Cos for water service at the County jail at
\$100⁰⁰ per annum, payable quarterly.
