The official bond of J. C. Walton, elected Nov. 5th 1889, as Treasurer of Douglas County, was filed in the office of the County Clerk and this day presented to the Board of County Commis of said county for approval.

said bond was signed by J. C. Walton, as Principal, in the penal sum of One hundred thousand dollars, and by Jacob House, R. M. Bruce, J. D. Fincher, C. J. Petty, Alexander Shaw, W. B. Romelick, John Barber, John A. Dailly, K. J. Snyder, Wm. Cratt and A. Tenley as sureties.

The Board having said bond under consideration and believing the law to be substantially complied with, approved the same.

The Board then proceeded to the examination of claims against the County.
