I would respectfully represent to your Hon. Body that the original plat of the City of Eudora Kansas, was destroyed during the "Quantrill Raid" that a copy of the same has been made, together with two "Record Books" showing title to many of the lots and blocks in said City of Eudora.

That the said plat and records may be legalized by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, I ask your Hon. Body to issue an order to the Register of Deeds of said County, permitting me to take said plat and record books to Topeka Kansas, for the aforesaid purpose.
