Road Petitioned for by
James Baker

On the 4th day of October 1890 a road Petition signed by James Baker and 22 others, was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the Location of a certain road as follows:

Beginning at the center of Sec 14. in T 15. R 18. Thence East (1/2) one half mile. Thence South (1/2) one half mile to County line.

Said Petition was accompanied with a bond signed by John H. Baker as surety and James Baker as principal as required by law.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and in appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was "ordered" that Abram Smith, Wm. Messenhamer and E. W. Fisher be appointed as viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning in Marion Township on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
