Creek in Wakarusa Township. And the sum of \$550.00 for
the construction of the Sibley bridge in Palmyra Twp.
or so much of the aforesaid amounts as may be necessary
to pay for the same when completed and accepted by the
Board of County Commrs.

Road

In the matter of a
Road Petitioned for by
James R. Kelly

The aforesaid petition of Jas. R. Kelly
and others as records in Comm. Record E. Page 353. being
under consideration the following action thereon was had by
the Board of County Commissioners to wit:
Upon due consideration no legal objections having been
offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter
mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility
it is "Ordered" that the viewers report of view and report
and plat of survey be adopted, as follows.

Beginning at the NW corner of Sec 21. T. 13. R. 19. Thence east
on Sec. line 44.87 chains to a stake in old road.
and that said road be declared located and established as a
public highway in accordance herewith. Full record
thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as
Road No. 459. And the Trustee of Wakarusa Township be noti-
fied to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 60 feet
wide.

The vacation of road, as prayed for in the afore-
said petition to be passed.
