

Road In the matter of a
Road Petitioned for by
H. Cantrell & others }

On the 11th day of Oct. 1890. a road petition signed by H. Cantrell and 16 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas. Praying for the location of a certain road described as follows.

Beginning in the center of County road no 180 at the corner of Sections No. 25, 26, 23rd & 24. T 13. R 20. E. Thence North on the section line between Sec^s 23rd & 24. one mile to intersect road No. 224.

It being the intention to reestablish said road No 224. as recorded in County Road Record "B." page 104.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond signed by H. Cantrell as Principal and A. W. Maderly as surety, in the amount of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, survey and laying out of said road. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was "Ordered" that Chas Letholz, W. L. Tuttle and J. R. Allen be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County surveyor at the place of beginning in Eudora township on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

M. D. Greenlee & others }

On the 10th day of October 1890 a road petition signed by M. D. Greenlee and 20 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas. Praying for the location of a certain road as follows.

Beginning in the center of Road No. 191 at the (1/2) half Sec^s line between Sec^s 26. T 14. R 20. and Sec 1. T 15. R 20. Thence west on section line (1/2) one and one half miles to intersect said Road No 191. (The same being a County road.)
