

Said petition was accompanied with a bond signed by
 W.D. Greenlee as Principal and C.M. Dishoff, as surety, in the
 amount of all costs and expenses accruing on the view, survey,
 and laying out of said road, in case the prayer of said
 petitioners be not granted,

Whereupon said bond was
 approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction
 of the Board that the law had been substantially
 complied with, It was "ordered" that F.B. Varnum
 P.H. Weeks and L.H. Tuttle, be appointed as viewers
 of the proposed road, and that they meet in
 conjunction with the County Surveyor, at the place
 of beginning in Palmyra township on the day des-
 ignated in their notice, and proceed to lay out
 said road according to law, giving to all parties
 a hearing and make due report of their proceedings
 to the County Board.

On motion Board adjourned to Oct 13th A.D. 1890.
