The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans.
met at the office of the County Clerk

Pursuant to adjournment.

All of the members and the County Clerk being present.

Road In the matter of a
Road petitioned for by
Henry E. Benson

On July 12th 1890. a road petition signed
by Henry E. Benson and 18 others was filed and this day presented
to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans.
praying for the relocation of a certain road in said
County as follows:

That part of Road numbered 216. run-
ning on the creek line of the North Fork 1/4 Sec 35. T13 R19.
Wakarusa Div.

The object being to place said road on the Section
line, it being demonstrated that that would make the better
road and be for the accommodation of all the travel
on said road.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond
signed by H. E. Benson as principle and Thos E. Evans as
surety. in the full amount of all costs and expenses
accruing on the view, survey and laying out of said road,
in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board
and in appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the
law had been substantially complied with. It was "Ordered"
that R R Doolittle, Wm Marshall and George Cade
be appointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they
meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place
of beginning in Wakarusa Div. on the day designated
in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said
road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing
and make due report of their proceedings to the County
Board.
