The Board gave a hearing to a large delegation of citizens and tax payers of Frank Township who presented petitions for two bridges across Mud Creek in said township, to wit:

One where Public road crosses said Creek on Sec line between S.E. 1/4 Sec 8th and N.E. 1/4 of Sec 17. T12 R20.

One between Sections 6th and 7. one half mile east of Burnett school house.

It appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with and that the aforesaid bridges were of public necessity, It was "Ordered"

Appropriation! That the sum of (\$300⁰⁰) three hundred dollars each, or so much thereof as is necessary to pay (1/2) one half of the cost of said bridges, payment to be made when same are completed and accepted by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas.
